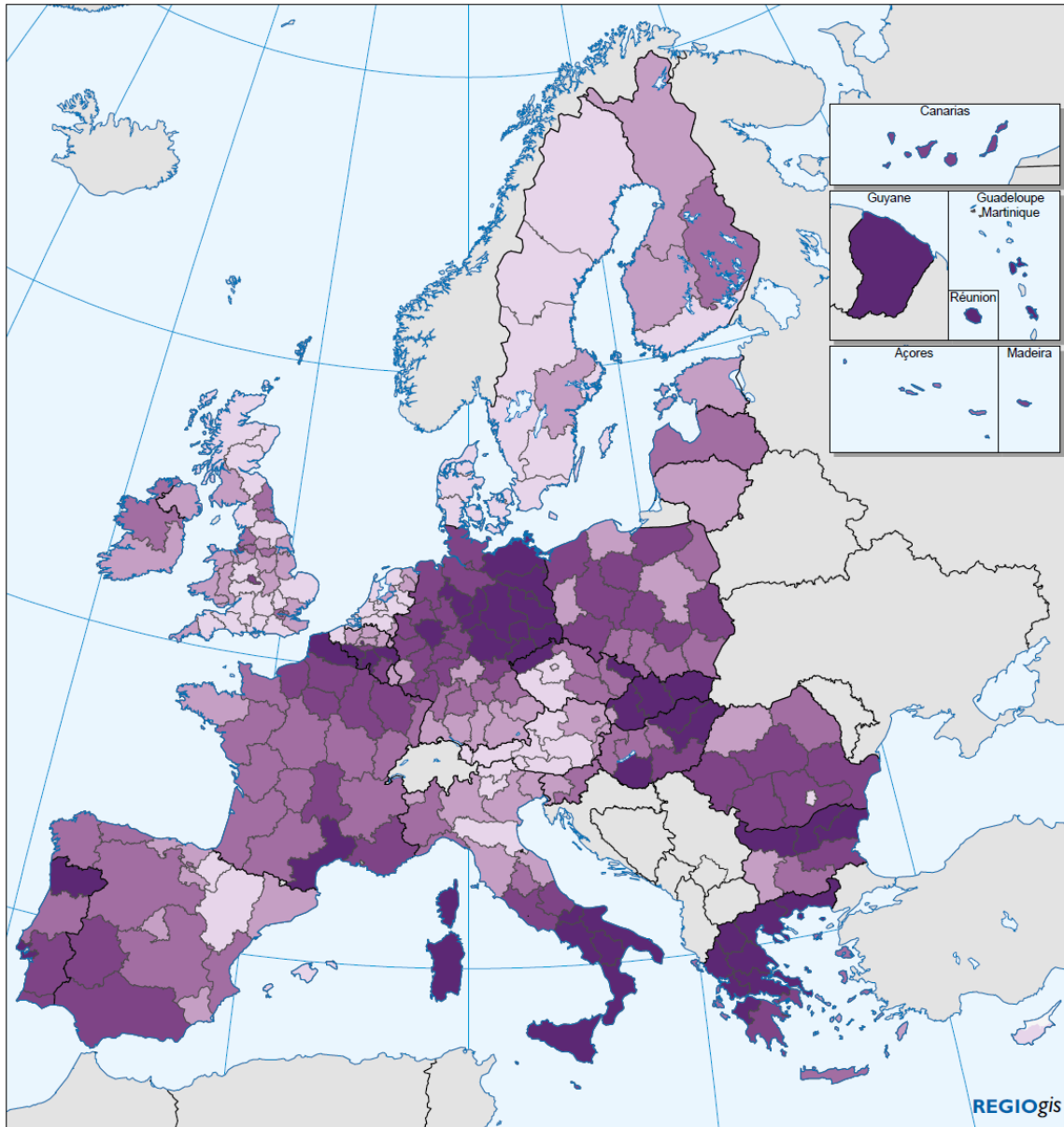

% of labour force

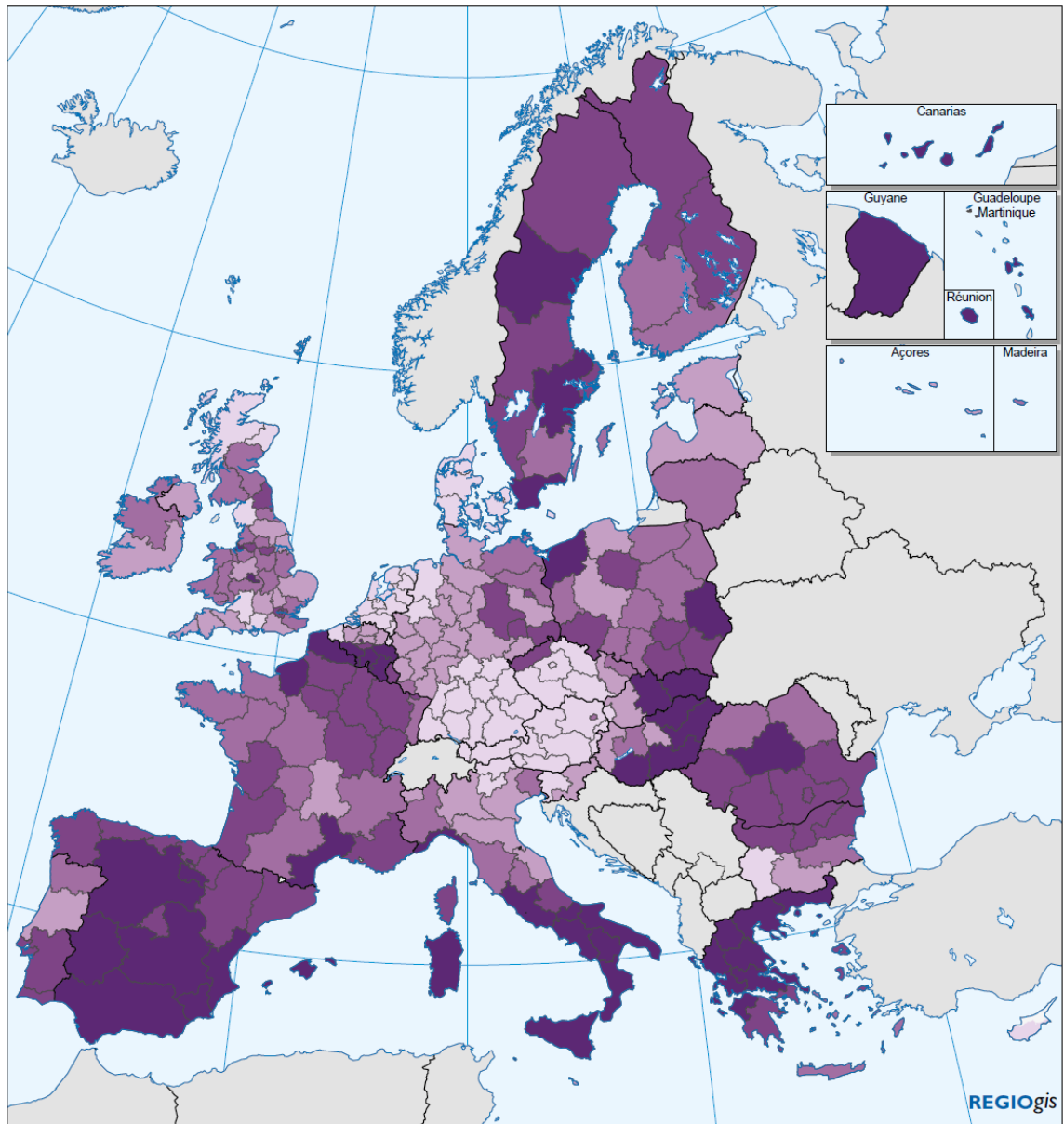

% of labour force aged 15-24

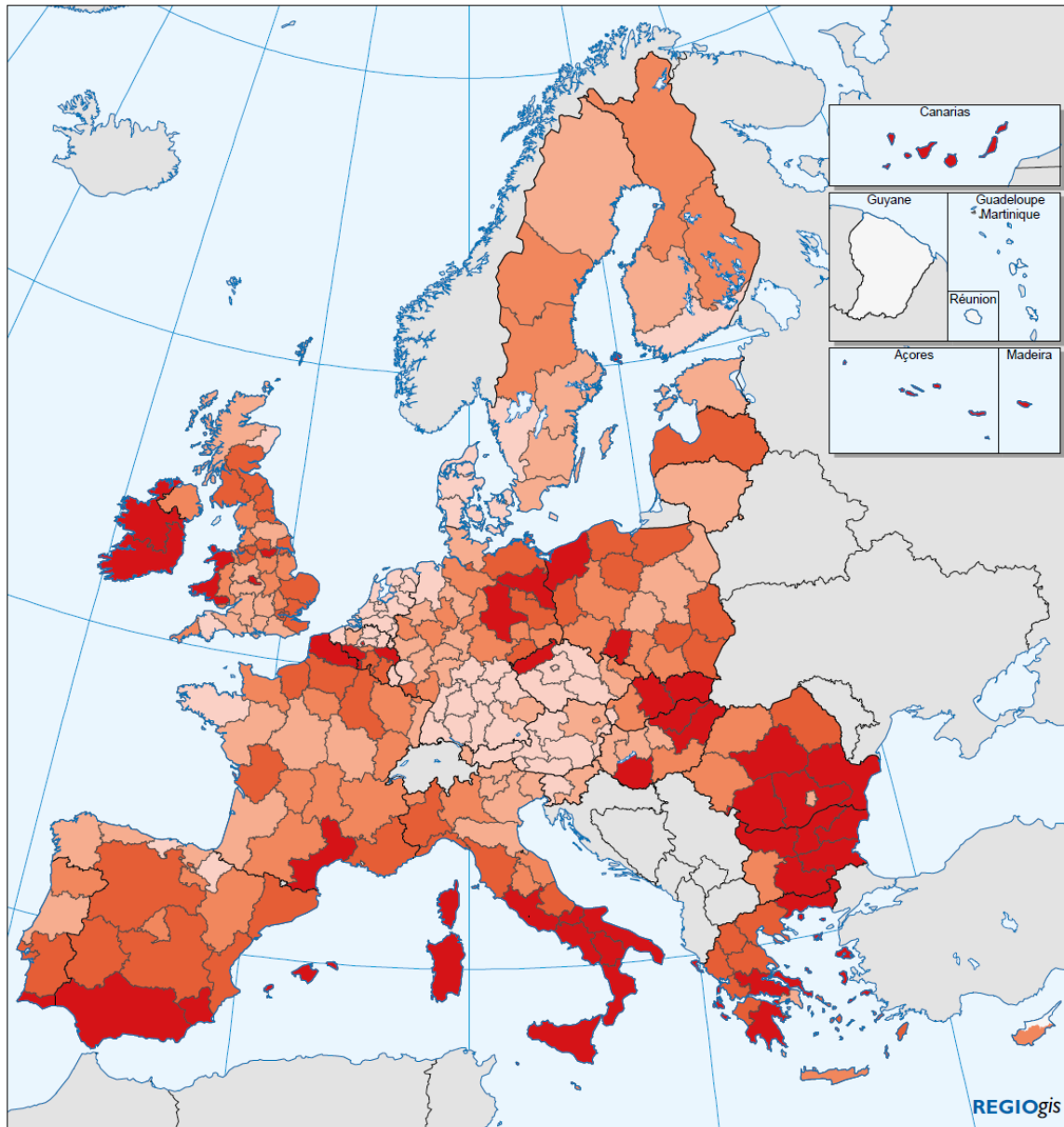

% of population aged 15-24

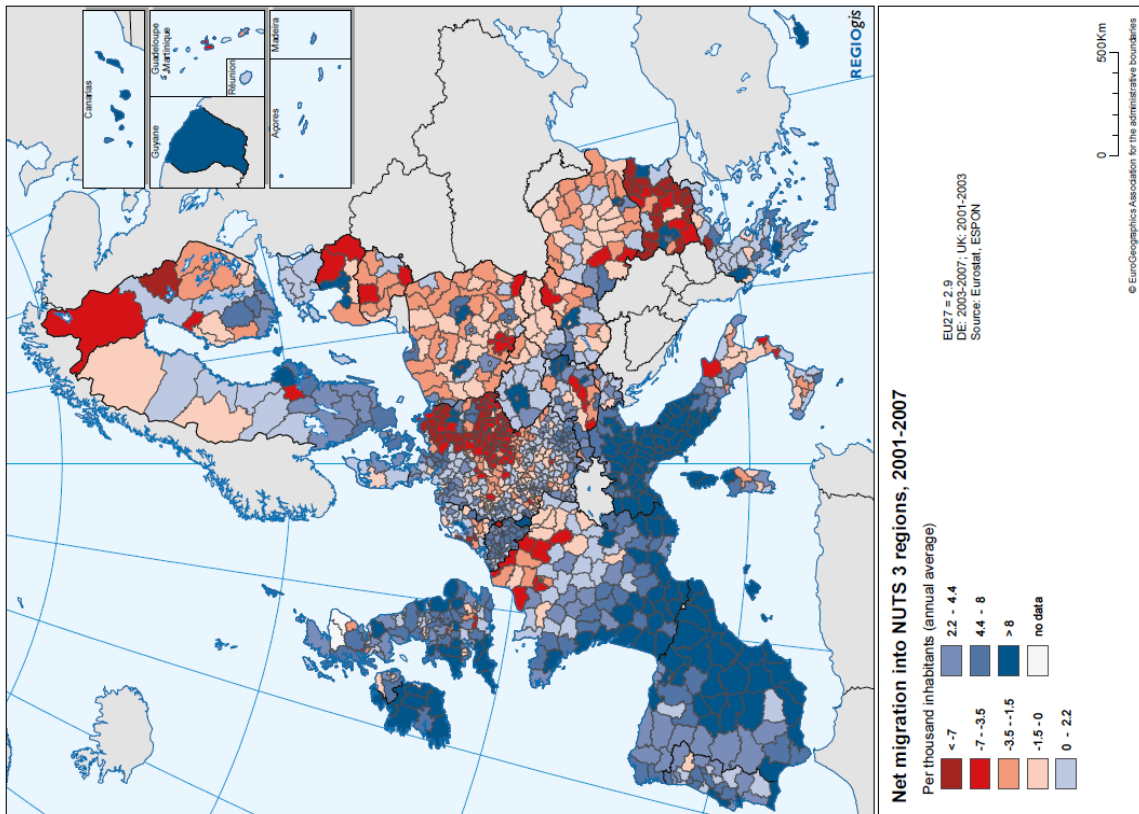
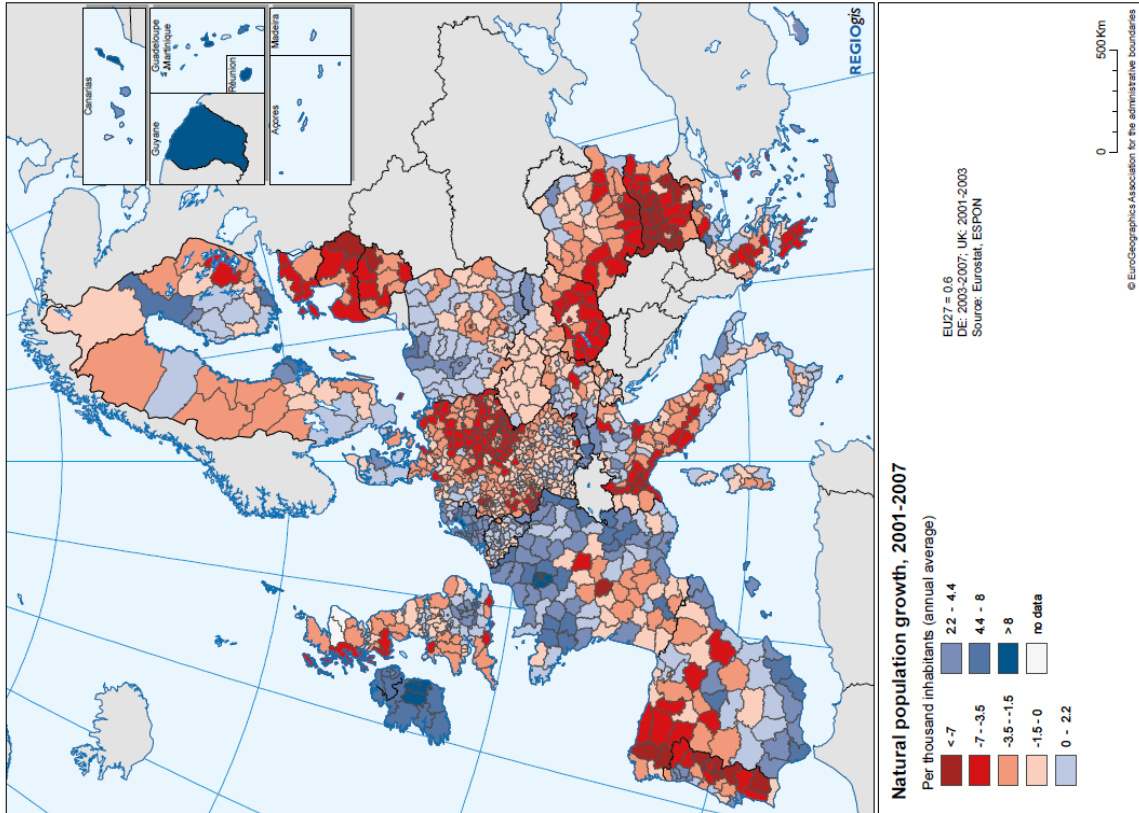

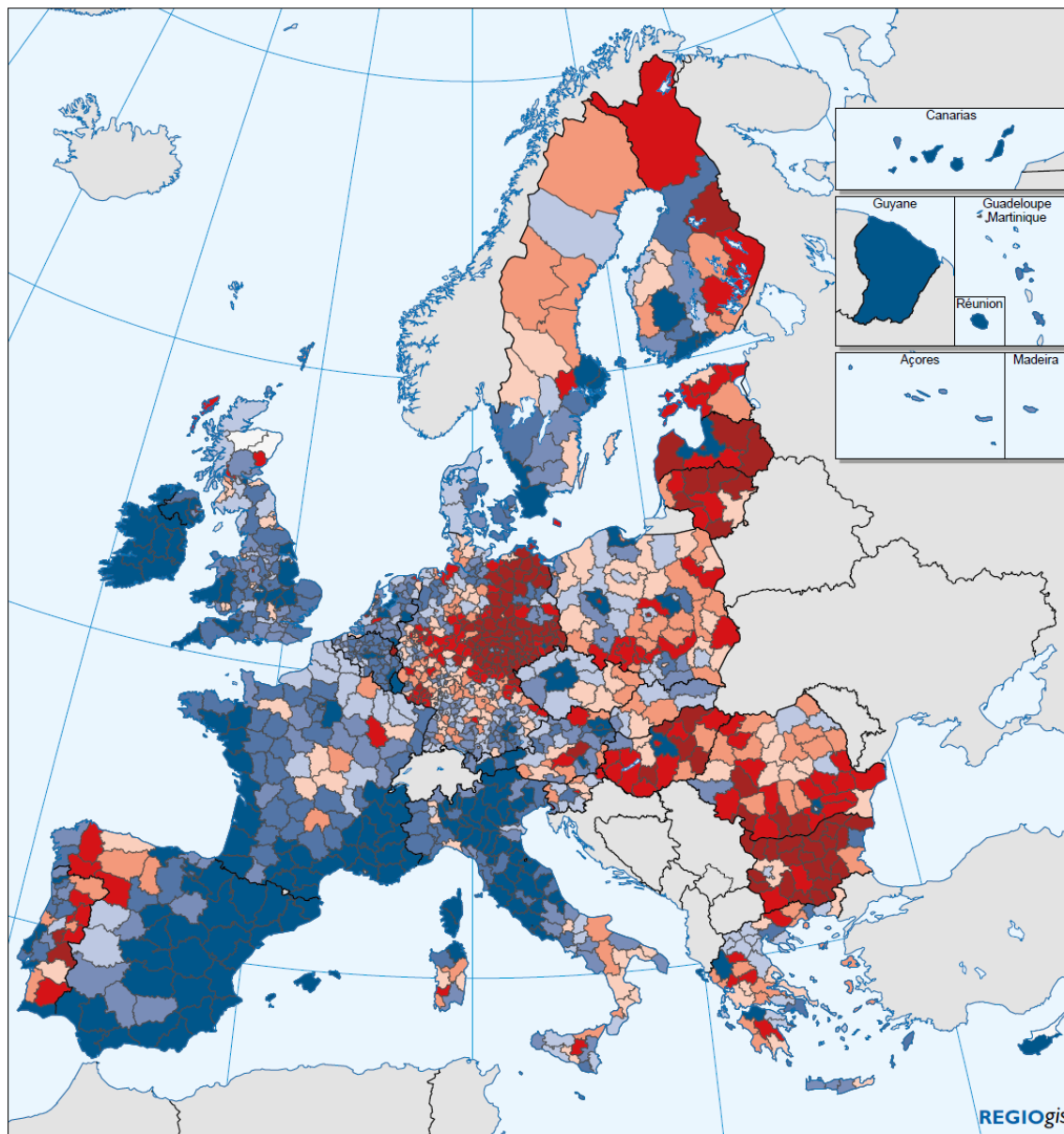

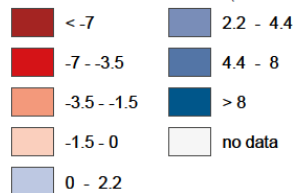

Per thousand inhabitants (annual average)

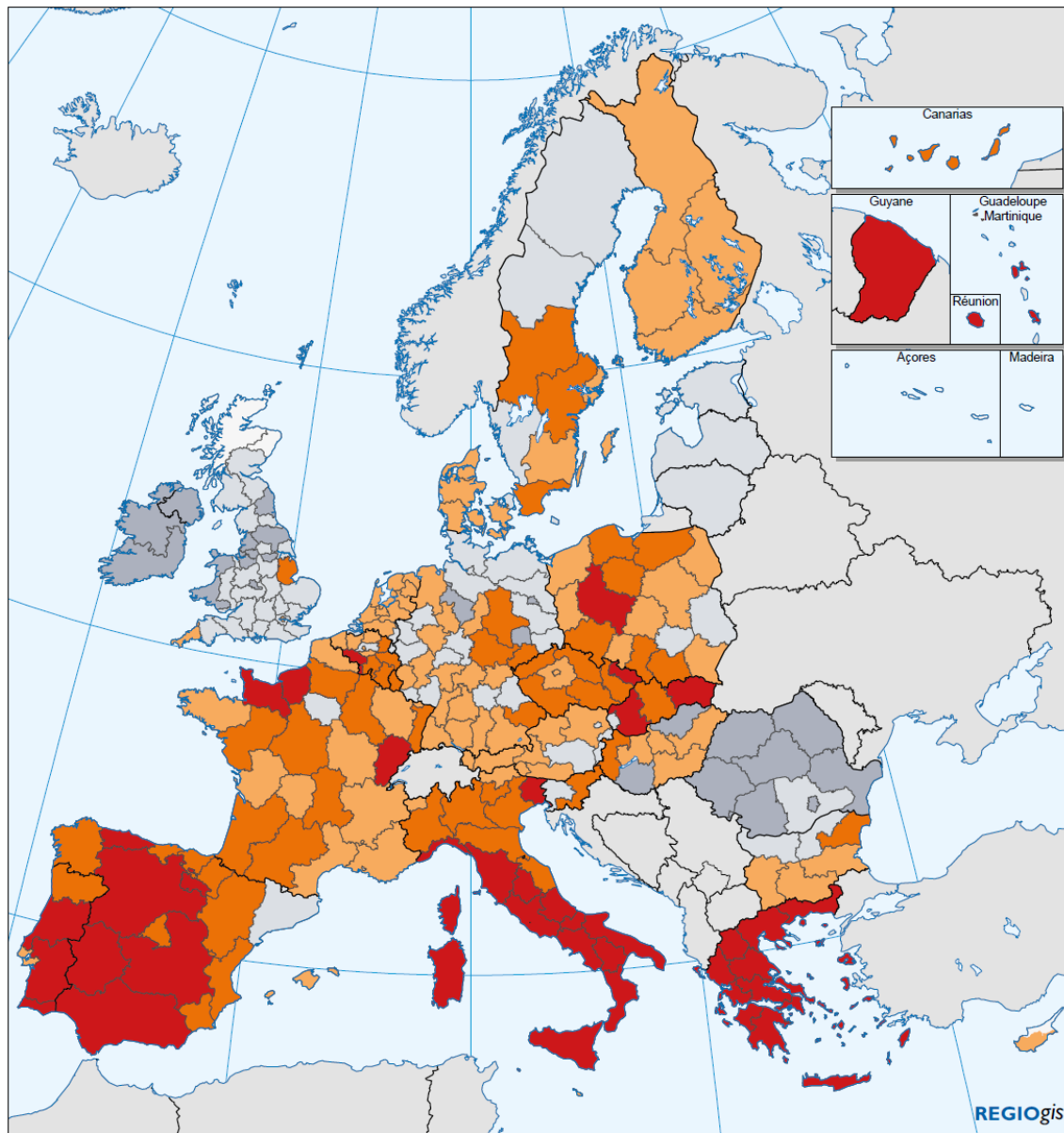

Percentage point difference (female-male)

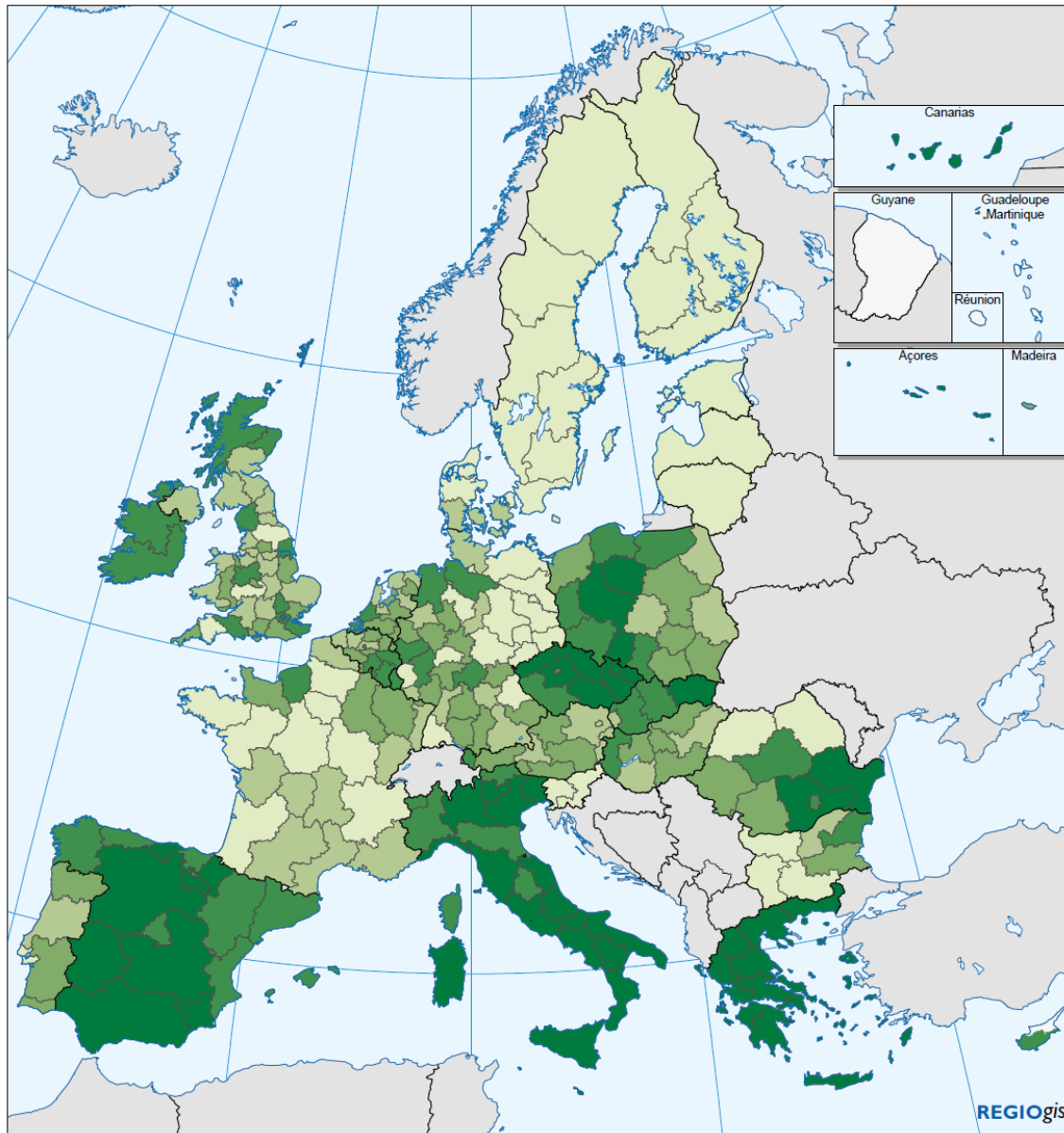

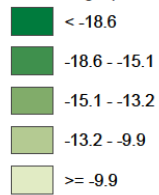
